

We're Going to ECO-Camp

What You Must Bring:

- your own lunch

What to Wear:

We will be outside all day – so dress in clothes comfortable for the temperature. It can be pretty chilly in the morning! We will be hiking on trails through the woods, and also be going into a muddy trail area, so you will want to wear:

- old jeans (that might get muddy)
- long-sleeve shirt
- boots/sturdy old shoes (that are good for hiking and that can get muddy)
- caps (we will be in the woods – and so will the ticks)

What You Should Bring:

- water bottle
- backpack
- insect repellent

NO CELL PHONES WILL BE ALLOWED DURING FIELD TRIP. CELL PHONES SHOULD BE LEFT AT HOME OR WILL BE LEFT ON THE BUS!!

Remember – you will be carrying anything that you bring.
